

NAGOVOR NOVEGA ADDRESS OF THE NEW PREDSEDNIKA ZGS PRESIDENT

Pozdravljeni, geodetinje in geodeti.

Delovanje Zveze geodetov Slovenije (ZGS), kot prostovoljnega združenja prijateljev geodezije, v obdobju 2024–2028 je osredotočeno na sinergijo gospodarskega dela geodetske stroke z izobraževalnima ustanovama (univerzo in srednjo šolo), društvi, javno upravo in Inženirsko zbornico Slovenije. Vidno mesto v zvezi mora imeti gospodarstvo ob uravnoteženosti vseh subjektov geodetske stroke, vključno z Geodetsko upravo Republike Slovenije (GURS), Fakulteto za geodezijo in gradbeništvo pri Univerzi v Ljubljani (UL FGG), Inženirsko zbornico Slovenije (IZS), Geodetskim inštitutom Slovenije (GIS), Gospodarsko interesnim združenjem geodetskih izvajalcev (GIZ-GI), Ministrstvom za naravne vire in prostor ter Srednjo gradbeno, geodetsko in okoljevarstveno šolo Ljubljana.

Gospodarski del geodezije in povezanih strok je treba še bolj negovati in mu posvečati več pozornosti zaradi nepredvidljivih razmer na gospodarskem področju, ki se napovedujejo v naslednjih letih. Pričakuje se hiter odziv vseh subjektov geodetske stroke in priprava skupne strategije »kako naprej«. Najprej se moramo vprašati, »kje smo« kot geodetska storitev v gospodarstvu, šele nato se vprašamo, »kam gremo«.

Delovanje ZGS v mandatnem obdobju je osredotočeno na: izdajanje Geodetskega vestnika, predvsem na nadaljevanje izhajanja strokovne publikacije, ki bo v letu 2027 praznovala 70-letnico, in organizacijo geodetskih dnevov. Obisk Geodetskega dneva se navezuje na ključen dejavnik iz preteklosti, saj šteje za pridobitev kreditnih točk za stalno poklicno usposabljanje pri IZS. Dogodek ponuja priložnost za sodelovanje in mreženje med strokovnjaki in podjetji v geodetski stroki. Še eno pomembno področje je nadaljevanje aktivnega sodelovanja v mednarodnih organizacijah, katerih članica je ZGS, ki bo še naprej podpirala vse mehanizme za uspešen razvoj stroke in skrbela za njen ugled.

Omeniti je treba, da je junija potekala redna skupščina, ki je bila hkrati volilna. Vesel sem, da so »mladi« (študenti geodezije) na skupščini prisotne prijetno opozorili, da tudi obstajajo in da ne smemo pozabiti nanje. Menim, da se nam ni treba bati za prihodnost geodezije.

Letošnje leto je pestro predvsem na področju športnega dogajanja, saj je olimpijsko, potekalo bo tudi svetovno prvenstvo v nogometu, kar pomeni, da bomo dobili še dodaten motiv za izzive geodetske stroke, ki prihajajo v prihodnjih letih.

Dear Surveyors,

The economy must have a prominent place, with the balance of all subjects of the surveying profession, including the Surveying and Mapping Authority of the Republic of Slovenia (GURS), the Faculty of Geodesy and Civil Engineering at the University of Ljubljana (UL FGG), the Slovenian Chamber of Engineers, the Geodetic Institute of Slovenia (GIS), the Economic Interest Grouping of Surveying Contractors (GIZ-GI), the Ministry of Natural Resources and Spatial Planning, and the Secondary School of Civil Engineering, Land Surveying and Environmental Studies Ljubljana.

Surveying and related professions should be nurtured, and even more attention should be paid to them due to the expected unpredictable economic conditions in the coming years. A quick response from all subjects of the surveying profession and the preparation of a joint 'how to proceed' strategy are expected. First, we must ask ourselves 'where we are' as a surveying service in the economy; only then can we ask ourselves 'where we are going'.

The activities of the ZGS during the mandate period are focused on the publication of Geodetski vestnik, aimed at continuing the publication of the professional publication, which will celebrate its 70th anniversary in 2027, and the organization of Land Surveying Days. Attendance at the Land Surveying Day has long been of key importance for professionals as it counts towards obtaining credit points for ongoing professional training at IZS. The event offers cooperation and networking opportunities between experts and companies in the surveying profession. Another important area is the continuation of active participation in international organizations of which ZGS is a member; this will continue to support all mechanisms for the successful development of the profession and enhance its reputation.

It should be noted that the annual general assembly was held in June, together with regular elections. I am glad that the 'young' (students of surveying) at the assembly provided a subtle reminder for everybody present that they also exist and that we should not forget about them. I don't think we need to fear for the future of surveying.

This year is especially varied in terms of sporting events, as it is an Olympic year, and the World Cup in football will also take place. This means that we will have an additional motive for the challenges of the surveying profession that are expected in the coming years.

We have already forgotten about the pandemic and the adjustments imposed on us in our everyday work. We can no longer imagine Land Surveying Days without personal contact between friends of geodesy, which is why preparations for the 52nd Land Surveying Day, which will take place on October 8 and 9 in Maribor, are already underway. This time, it will be hosted by the Society of Surveyors from Northeast Slovenia.

I invite you to participate in this year's Land Surveying Day.
