Jesenski del leta tradicionalno prinaša naloge, med katerimi so tako strokovna srečanja kot nadaljnje izpolnjevanje strateških ciljev Zveze geodetov. V marcu 2025 je Geodetska uprava RS sklical sestanek, na katerem smo bili seznanjeni z glavnimi poudarki Programa geodetskih del za leto 2025 ter z bližajočim se pripisom posodobljenih vrednosti nepremičnin in obveščanjem lastnikov z zbirkami potrdil.

Na sestanku so sodelovali vsi ključni deležniki geodetske stroke (GURS, FGG, GIZ-GI, IZS, GIS, DSICGEOS). Osrednja tema srečanja je bilo stanje v stroki po sprejetju novega Zakona o katastru nepremičnin. Sklenili smo, da se bomo odslej srečevali redno, najmanj enkrat letno, saj se vsako leto nabere dovolj aktualnih tem za izmenjavo pogledov in stališč.

Vsa društva, ki spadajo pod okrilje ZGS, delujejo odlično. Njihov utrip je ves čas prisoten, kar nas navdaja z optimizmom za prihodnost. Dear surveyors,

The post-vacation period is always an opportunity to look back – to review the work accomplished and successes that marked the past months, as well as to embrace the fresh energy that autumn brings. This season marks the beginning of a period full of activities, plans, and commitments for the Association of Surveyors of Slovenia every year.

Autumn has always been associated with efforts invested in both professional meetings and ongoing work towards the achievement of the Association's strategic goals. The fresh start provides a welcome motivational boost to join forces and tackle our major tasks. September is also the time when the Association's General Assembly takes place bringing the review of the year's activities.

In March 2025, the Surveying and Mapping Authority of the Republic of Slovenia organised a meeting as an opportunity to present the priorities foreseen in the Surveying Work Programme for 2025. Participants were also informed on the latest developments in the field of real estate valuation and the system of notification of owners through certificates.

All key stakeholders in surveying participated in the meeting (representatives of the Surveying and Mapping Authority; the Faculty of Civic and Geodetic Engineering; the Economic Interest Group of Surveyors; the Slovenian Chamber of Engineers; the Geodetic Institute of Slovenia; and the Society of Court Experts and Certified Appraisers in Surveying). The central topic of the meeting was the impact of the new Real Estate Cadastre Act on the profession. It was agreed that meetings become regular and take place at least once a year, for everybody to be able to exchange views on current issues and developments in the field.

The societies under the Association are functioning well. Their momentum can be felt far and wide and generates optimism for the future. Innovative networking concepts have become a constant in both social and professional events organised by societies. Thus, the foreseeable future may well bring a welcome change making people step away from modern technology with its alienation effects. We will be able to reconnect with nature and others, to reestablish close contacts, which are an essential need of every human being.

The Association working group responsible for the development of surveying strategy met for the third time in 2025. We at the Association consider that the present strategy, which demanded considerable efforts in the past, needs to be re-evaluated and modernised. This document is vital for the development of our profession as the advent of new technologies in recent decades has significantly expanded the role of surveyors. It is necessary to carefully define the role of the profession in the future, as surveyors must be equipped to provide adequate answers to the developmental challenges of modern societies.

A well-designed strategy calls for collaboration from all stakeholders in the surveying profession and related fields. The Association remains an important player and will continue to promote professional and social events that strengthen existing contacts and the cooperation network.

In this spirit, we are intensively preparing the 53rd Slovenian Land Surveying Day, which will be organised this year by the Dolenjska Surveying Society under the title "Geodesy and Energy: United in Spatial Development" on October 15th and 16th in Čatež ob Savi.
